I. ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

Applicant must be a high school senior or a returning college student for the 2018/2019 calendar year. He/She is responsible to have an educator at the school attended submit a recommendation as to the applicant's academic work, character, activities, etc. as well as official transcripts of SAT/ACT test scores (High School Seniors) to the Scholarship Committee by Friday, April 15, 2019. The candidate must complete parts II-IX hereby attached, sign and date said application and return completed document to the Ladies Philoptochos Scholarship Committee no later than Friday, April 15, 2019.

At least one member of the applicant's family must be a steward in good standing of Saint John the Baptist Greek Orthodox Church in Myrtle Beach, SC and in good standing within the Orthodox faith. Applicant must also include a Letter of Recommendation from a Parish Priest (FORM ATTACHED). Applicant must have maintained a minimum 2.75 on a 4.0 scale during the entire school course of study. He/She must also be a current or past 4-year high school active youth member of St. John the Baptist Greek Orthodox Church *or* other Greek Orthodox Church.

Selection of the applicant is at the discretion of the Scholarship Committee, and is based on academic achievement, character, personal merit and financial need. Merit is demonstrated in a variety of ways: leadership in school, civic and other extracurricular events, participation in Greek Orthodox Church activities and motivation to serve and succeed.
