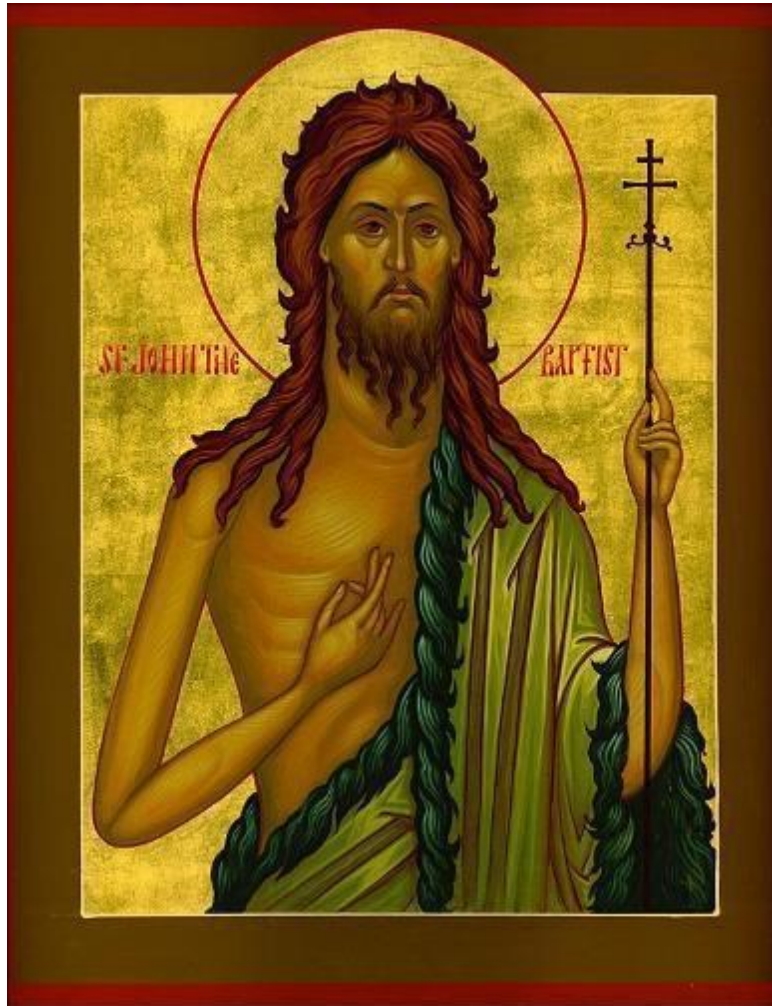

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

In order to apply and be eligible for the scholarship, the applicant must satisfy all of the following:

- 1.1 High school senior in the current year graduation class.
- 1.2 Must have been active in church youth activities for 2 years prior to graduation.
- 1.3 Maintained a "B" average (3.0 on 4.0 scale) during the high school course of study.
- 1.4 Applicant will be attending on full time basis to an accredited college/university.
- 1.5 Applicant must be present to receive the Scholarship on the church designate graduate day.

Filing

- 2.1 Complete all sections of the application.
- 2.2 Include a copy of your High School transcript.
- 2.3 Include a copy of your college acceptance letter.
- 2.4 Applicant is responsible for the submission of all documents and completion of all sections of the application.
- 2.5 Incomplete applications will be disqualified.
- 2.6 All information received will be kept confidential. No items will be returned. Applications must be complete with no outstanding information forthcoming.
